### **NZ** General Facts and Figures:

- Police are called to around 200 domestic incidents on average a day; that is one every seven minutes
- On average 14 Women, 10 Children and 6 Men are killed by a member of their family every year
- 24% of Women and 6% of Men have experienced one or more sexual offences at some point in their lives
