

Profile on Injury Data for Hastings

This factsheet presents all age data on injury deaths and injury hospitalisations by numbers, rates, the three leading causes, gender, ethnicity and place where the injury death occurred. The data for injury deaths were sourced via the Injury Prevention Research Unit (IPRU) from the New Zealand Health Information Service (NZHIS) for the year 2002 (the most recent year for which injury death data was available). The data for injury hospitalisations were sourced via the IPRU from the NZHIS for the year 2004 (the most recent year for which injury hospitalisation data were available). Separate analysis from these data sets for the 0-19 year age group were also conducted.

INJURY DEATHS:

- ⇒ During 2002, 25 people from Hastings died as a result of an injury.
- ⇒ Motor Vehicle Traffic was the leading cause of injury death (n=6).

- ⇒ During 2004, 931 people from Hastings were hospitalised overnight for treatment of an injury.
- ⇒ Falls were the leading cause of injury hospitalisations (n= 330).
